PRIVATE CASE broke sharply then settled into stride racing four wide, rallied into the stretch, showed good effort late and inched away. DIAMOND CHARM dueled from the outside, held a short lead at the eighth pole, and failed to hold of a closing rival to be outfinished. MISPLACED MEMO dueled from along the inside, weakened near the quarter pole but held the show. COCKTAILSFORFATMAN chased the early leader and lacked a closing effort late. GOSSIP DOME was void of early speed saving ground, angled out four wide and placed a bid late. FAST N RACY was off slow early, went five wide at the quarter pole, lacked a rally and was vanned off after pulling up. MORE FUN was unhurried early racing along the inside, angled four wide at the top of the stretch and went evenly late. SKIIN NIGHT showed little racing four wide in a dull effort. HUNTER HIGH was close in the early going, dropped back into the turn and was eased to the wire.
