SAPELLO CANTADOR chased the early leaders racing off the inside, angled out three wide to place a bid, responded well and surged clear. DESERT GULCH was outrun early saving ground, swung out six wide in the second turn and showed some effort late to gain the place. CHIEF LAZ set the early pace racing off the rail, drew clear in the second turn, was challenged in the stretch and came up empty. HEZA HOT SHOT was off slow early racing off the inside, angled out five wide and placed a mild bid. CROWNTHATBIRD raced mid pack off the inside and lacked a late response. DEITY pressed the early pace from the outside, drifted three wide in the stretch and faded. ONE FINE JEWEL was unhurried early, went between foes and showed little. BE RHYTHMIC was off slow early racing well behind the rail along the rail, angled out four wide in the stretch and was not a threat.
