Footnotes

DESERT CHILI settled early, advanced widest on the backstretch, four and five wide taking the second turn, all out through the stretch and caught SOME KIND OF LUCK nearing the wire. SOME KIND OF LUCK forwardly placed from the beginning, progressed between horses on the backstretch, gained a slight advantage two wide on the second turn, moved ahead from inside upper stretch, fought gamely but did not have enough left in the waning yards. D FINANCIER six to seven wide on the first turn, steadily advanced toward the outside to vie for the lead just outside SOME KIND OF LUCK on the second turn, was all out between rivals through the lane but lacked the extra needed. MOJAVE PRINCE not far off the early speed from between rivals the first half, was slow to respond just off the inside entering the second bend, found his best stride leaving that turn and steadily closed the gap through the stretch. BOODIC in contention early between horses, waited for room just off the inside on the second turn, got through four wide leaving that bend but weakened for the drive. GLENWOOD AUGGIE without early speed while toward the outside, commenced his bid three wide into the second turn, had a striking position with a quarter mile left but leveled off instead. COMIC TALK crowded briefly at the start, was hustled up to gain the lead on the first turn, moved clear leaving that bend, was overtaken while along the rail on the second turn and tired through the stretch. K D RANSOM helped prompt the pace three

wide on the backstretch, gained the rail into the second turn, faded and drifted out several times in the lane. BAD BOY BULL steadily faded from inside on the backstretch, came off the rail entering the second turn, was six wide into the stretch, lacked a rally and altered out to stay clear of K D RANSOM late. DANCING WITH BULLS broke on top and outward, gradually gave way from inside, just off the rail through the second turn and empty for the drive. PLAYNATHEFUNERAL was away slowly, soon angled in and showed little. GROOMSTICK EM five to six wide taking the first turn, was prominent between rivals on the backstretch but gave way four wide on the second bend.
