Footnotes

CONTESSA DEL NORTE was within striking distance early, vied four wide nearing the quarter pole, was full of run late, surged clear and widened. GON TO RUN set the early pace along the rail, lost the lead into the second turn, angled out near the eighth pole, rallied splitting foes and came back to get up for the place. OLIVE HUNTER was allowed to settle early, loomed up four wide to gain the lead briefly then weakened in the drive. MI CASTA prompted the early pace from the outside and was finished early. SEXY IN STILETTOS was off slow early, raced six wide and improved her position. WEENSIE was close in the early going saving ground, angled out between rivals, gained a short lead into the second turn then faded. SLEWS GLORY was void of early speed, went five wide and was not a factor. PERFUME AND ROUGE broke poorly then gained ground along the rail, angled between foes, moved up to lead briefly between calls then retreated and was eased to the wire.
