OCEANOR forced the early pace from the outside, placed a bid to duel into deep stretch, dug in nearing the wire and inched away. STRUT N TUTT was allowed to settle early, went four wide into the stretch, rallied in deep stretch and was gaining in deep stretch. SHOOTITALL was outrun early racing off the inside, vied nearing the eighth pole six wide and showed some effort late. CHARLIE TUNA set the early pace saving ground and weakened after a half. WARREN'S MR. LUCKY was forwardly placed early four wide and lacked a closing rally. FLEETING SUMMER was outrun early saving ground and showed little throughout. T DRIVE was void of early speed, went five wide and passed a tiring foe. VALERA ROYAL was never far back early racing along the rail, angled out to make a move mid way then faded. EL RIFLE was unhurried early racing five wide at the quarter, went wrong nearing the eighth pole, was taken up and vanned off.
