Footnotes

QUINTON'S FIRE soon had the lead, was just off the inside through the bend, challenged from outside in the lane, battled under mild urging and prevailed. KISS MY HENNESSY stumbled at the break, advanced between rivals, engaged QUINTON'S FIRE from just outside at the top of the stretch, fought gamely, was narrowly outfinished but stayed clear for the place. SLEW UP HIS SLEEVE bumped with INDY'S RANSOM at the break, followed QUINTON'S FIRE through the turn, altered outside that one upper stretch, could not close the gap and narrowly held the show. INDY'S RANSOM bumped with SLEW UP HIS SLEEVE at the start, chased from between horses, was just off the rail into the turn, lost ground as he floated out to path five leaving the bend and found best stride too late the last furlong. S P K LANES HEART broke slowly and awkwardly, progressed four wide on the turn then had to alter his path abruptly twice to advance in traffic through the stretch. YOUR LUCKY TIME displayed early speed from inside, could not keep up on the bend, drifted out some inside the last eighth and had to be vanned off after the race. TRIPPIN ON JAXON in contention from outside, was forced out some entering the stretch, began to tire and lug in midstretch, was steadied to avoid S P K LANES HEART and continued to fade. MR. MCCOY just off the inside most of the way, was not a factor. TOBAPRINCE steadily faded along the rail.
