**Footnotes**

CHARMING DELTA bumped from the rear after the start, disputed the pace between horse, was in path three entering the stretch, battled through the lane, drew clear just inside the sixteenth marker, ducked in under a left whip nearing the wire but held on. DONA ANA was prominent between horses from the early going, advanced along the rail on the turn, came off the rail some at the head of the lane, was still blocked, split rivals four wide nearing the sixteenth marker, was closing in then forced out to avoid CHARMING DELTA in the final strides. POKER QUEEN soon trailed, was taken outside midway on the backstretch, lost ground through the bend, fanned to path seven for the stretch run, steadily made up ground and got third late. HOLLYWOOD MOON vied for the lead toward the outside, was three to five wide taking the turn, jostled with REAL COMIC several times in deep stretch, was forced out by the latter near the wire and checked as she hit the finish line. REAL COMIC weaved out and in after the break, bumping CHARMING DELTA, raced in contention toward the outside, came four wide into the lane, jostled repeatedly with HOLLYWOOD MOON as she was closing the gap the final furlong then altered out and checked hard as she tried to stay clear of DONA ANA in the final jump. SUJEY contested the early pace, had the rail on the turn, fought in the lane but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. SHEZ OUR INFLUENCE broke inward, bumped with LOVELY LYNX a couple times, advanced three wide on the turn, altered in upper stretch when DONA ANA took her path and leveled off the final furlong. GOLD SCAT bumped at the start, was settled, just off the inside on the turn, fanned six wide into the lane and passed some tired ones. JULIEANNA B displayed early speed from outside, came five wide into the stretch and flattened out. ROSE FROST was an early contender just off the rail but faded inside on the bend. HOLLYWOOD LOOP was hustled along from

inside but steadily gave way. LOVELY LYNX bumped repeatedly at the break, was checked, taken outside, lost ground widest through the turn, quit in the stretch and had to be vanned off. There was a stewards' inquiry into the deep stretch run and an objection lodged by the rider of HOLLYWOOD MOON alleging interference from DONA ANA and CHARMING DELTA in the final strides. After their review, the stewards found the incident happened too late to alter the outcome.
