Footnotes

DESERT GAMBLE broke inward, was rated on the front end between horses, fanned outside SPY MASK for the drive, took over nearing the sixteenth marker then quickly opened up under mild urging. SPY MASK also broke inward, was bumped and forced into HOLLYWOOD BRANDY at the start, quickly recovered to gain the advantage between rivals, moved ahead on the turn, floated out to path three for the stretch run, began to wear down the last furlong and narrowly held his position. KEY TO THE BAND soon trailed from inside, swung to the outside leaving the turn, rallied from the middle of the track, gradually lugged in then was altered out some nearing the wire. PALACIO was prominent between horses from the beginning, four wide on the turn, altered in for a clear path upper stretch then lacked the needed bid. POPZ broke inward, bumping SPY MASK, was an early contender between horses, just off the inside entering the turn, swung six wide for the drive and could only make up minor ground late. SILVA TUNG DEVIL was a factor toward the outside on the backstretch, improved position three wide on the turn but leveled off in the lane. TURBULENT TOUCH pressed from outside, took the bend five wide then flattened through the stretch. HOLLYWOOD BRANDY away slowly, was then steadied behind traffic, had the rail on the turn, floated out some entering the lane and had little to offer. WHOS LAZY dueled for the lead from inside, was steadied when his path was taken into the turn, remained inside and gave way leaving the turn.
