### Footnotes

STOP THE SPENDING showed first, was rated off the early speed from outside, roused four wide on the bend, gained the advantage inside the final furlong, moved ahead and held on under hand urging. UH OH TRAFFIC also rated off the early speed, found herself blocked just off the inside on the bend, was checked lacking room upper stretch, altered out leaving the eighth pole, jostled with DUALITY, was steadied slightly, had clear sailing the last sixteenth and took over second as she closed the gap. DUALITY shared the lead three wide, did not keep up leaving the turn, came in a bit just as UH OH TRAFFIC came out just inside the eighth pole, was checked approaching the final sixteenth and finished evenly. SUDDEN GHOST contested the pace between horses and slowly yielded deep stretch. SNOW RIDGE BLISS settled inside, picked up her pace on the bend, was altered out upper stretch, altered outside STOP THE SPENDING after entering the last furlong and could not close the gap. AFRICAN ROSE dueled for the lead from inside most of the way but weakened in the late going. HOT AND GOLD gradually faded from outside, was pulled up in distress entering the turn and vanned off. There was a stewards' inquiry into the jostling that went on between UH OH TRAFFIC and DUALITY inside the last furlong but no action taken after their review.
