TIE ROD was unhurried early, raced four wide down the backstretch, rallied nearing the quarter pole, gained the lead then drew clear and held well. BRONZE FOX chased the early leaders from between rivals, angled in along the rail in the stretch, lacked a gain late but held the place. STAR SURPRISE was within striking distance early four wide, lost ground into the second turn, came back in the stretch with a mild bid. HAPPY TOES was void of early speed, went five wide into the stretch and showed some effort late. MINISTERS POWER was allowed to settle early, saved ground while placing a brief bid then weakened. FRANKSASSESEDVALU was a bit hard to rate into the first turn racing along the inside then gave way. SERVICE HAWK was outrun early, raced wide throughout and passed a tiring foe in the stretch. INDIAN WEAVER showed early speed racing off the inside, drew clear, held til into the second turn then drifted out in the stretch and faded.
