**Footnotes**

SPEEDY FALCON hustled into the first turn and emerged on the backside with a clear lead while rating under a long hold, began to move clear on the second turn and then drew off entering the stretch while kept to steady urging. SISTER SWANK was beaten to the first turn by the winner and had to check, then tracked that rival to the head of the stretch without threatening but proved second best. SKYLADYSKY was within reach two wide between nearing the stretch and was outfinished for the place but proved best of the rest. AMERICA AMERICA was along the rail on the backstretch but checked back from tight quarter nearing the far turn and raced evenly the rest of the way. SATINE lost ground six or seven wide into the stretch but still improved position. MISS NOTEWORTHY made a brief bid three wide late on the far turn but then flattened through the drive. HOMEMAKER took the turn three wide between foes, then angled out for clear sailing into the lane but failed to make a bid. SHE'S THE GENERAL gave chase two wide between rivals down the backstretch but was already tiring on the second turn. COKE'S MELODY checked into the first turn and was through early.
