Footnotes

BATTLE DOME broke alertly, was rated just off the early speed between rivals, swung out five wide entering the turn, had the advantage from path six entering the lane, gradually drifted out under a left whip, was switched to stern right-hand pressure near the sixteenth marker, held a straight path while kept to a drive and shook free. BLUE EYED CAT broke poorly, progressed between horses, was blocked nearing the bend, got through three wide on the turn, swung outside BATTLE DOME leaving the bend, was slowly forced out by the latter as he bid for the lead midstretch, began to back up inside the final sixteenth and finished in hand. WICKED EISHIN in contention early toward the outside, advanced five wide on the turn, lost even more ground as he was carried out by BLUE EYED CAT into the stretch, gradually closed the gap as he angled out to stay clear of the latter and took over third late. LESS ODDS duelled for the lead between horses on the backstretch, was outrun into the turn, waited for room just off the rail, altered out behind BATTLE DOME at the top of the lane, soon gained a clear path as the latter drifted out, had every chance with a furlong left but hung in the waning yards. ASSAULT N BATTERY a factor between rivals on the backstretch, failed to keep up taking the bend three to five wide, lodged his bid leaving the turn, regained a striking position

but could not make up further ground the last eighth. DUDE ON THE LOOSE contested the pace from outside, took the turn four wide and wore down for the drive. ICE BOY forwardly placed from inside, altered out three wide for a clear path upper stretch and weakened the final eighth. WILD SWEEP broke well but soon trailed from outside, stayed well off the inside on the bend, swung seven wide for the stretch run and passed tired ones. EL PROSPECTO chased the early speed from outside, was widest taking the turn and flattened out the last two and a half furlongs. HOLLYWOOD DUDE vied for the lead from inside for a half mile then began to fade. FIRE E BEAN displayed early speed between horses but gave way two wide leaving the turn. SEE YA TOOTS dueled for the lead between rivals for more than a half mile, came three wide into the stretch and faltered. The rider of BLUE EYED CAT lodged an objection alleging interference from BATTLE DOME in the lane. After their review, the stewards could not uphold that view and made no change.
