TWELVE TWENTY TWO chased the early leader from the outside, sustained a bid nearing the quarter pole, gained the lead, edged clear and increased her advantage. AMERICAN STORY settled four wide in the second flight, began to close the gap nearing the quarter pole, finished willingly in the stretch but was no match for the winner. HAYLEY'S HALO set the early pace drawing clear while saving ground, was challenged near the quarter pole and came up empty in the drive. MISS HEATHER LEE was well back in the early going saving ground and placed a mild effort late. TWIST was outrun early, went three wide and lacked a closing response. CAMILLE C was unhurried early racing five wide and failed to threaten. QUEEN GREELEY was allowed to settle early saving ground, angled four wide in the stretch and gave way.
