Footnotes

DISAPPEARING FLY blocked behind the early speed, altered out five wide leaving the turn, moved clear upper stretch and was kept to urging until the waning yards. HEZA ALLIGATOR raced in midpack between horses, was steadied just off the inside on the turn, swung out six wide leaving the bend, moved clear for second inside the final furlong but was no match for DISAPPEARING FLY. I SEE RED forced out shortly after the start, was blocked and waited three wide leaving the turn, lost ground fanning seven wide into the lane then got up for third late. GREAT ARTURO hesitated at the break, was angled in after entering the main track, swung four wide into the turn, lacked a significant stretch response but steadily improved his position. MAKENNA'S GOLD disputed the pace two wide, took the rail on the turn, could not hold back DISAPPEARING FLY upper stretch and wore down the final furlong. YOUR

FLYING DUTCH in midpack between horses, also was blocked while just off the inside on the bend, altered out to the middle of the track upper stretch and steadily advanced without threatening. ROANIE'S STAR vied for the lead between rivals, was three wide leaving the turn then flattened out for the drive. NO TRICK displayed early speed from outside but tired through the lane. BANGOR contested the pace three wide, angled in some on the turn and also wore down when the serious running started. MR. PLAY MISTY void of speed, faded between horses early in the turn, came three wide into the lane, angled out upper stretch and passed tired ones. FIRE E BEAN chased from outside, came into contention just off the inside on the turn but could not sustain his bid in the stretch. LEE'S BREEZE dueled for the early lead just off the inside, took the rail into the bend and began to tire.
