REMUS bumped with BROAD BEACH at the start, was settled behind traffic, moved to the rail midway on the turn, took over upper stretch then steadily drew off under a mild drive. GO GETEM advanced to the second flight from between rivals, was three then four wide taking the turn, under steady urging in the lane and caught HIPOCRISY near the wire for second. HIPOCRISY broke alertly, shook free midway on the backstretch, stayed just off the inside through the bend, was no match for REMUS when set down for the drive and slowly wore down deep stretch. Q P'S PONY PUPPY was angled out early, raced in contention while toward the outside, widest taking the turn then could only make up minor ground on the second flight in the waning yards. BROAD BEACH bumped with REMUS at the start, was a factor from outside on the backstretch, four wide through the bend and lacked a significant stretch bid. TIGER BAY gradually backed up from inside, was just off the rail through the turn and drifted out late. MY RIKELY in the second flight between horses, gave way along the rail on the turn.
