**Footnotes**

ENDORSEMENT stalked the early speed from just outside, came to CONVEYANCE when let out some on the second bend, was roused two wide leaving that turn, soon took over, was clear with a sixteenth to go then continued to widen and was ridden out through the waning yards. CONVEYANCE broke alertly, was soon clear, showed the way in hand from inside, was put to a drive on the second turn, proved no match for ENDORSEMENT the last eighth but was unchallenged for the place. TEMPTED TO TAPIT was prominent just outside the top pair from the early going, three wide through the second turn, drifted out some midstretch, was corrected and could only hold his position late. FOG ALERT without early foot just off the inside, had the rail on the second turn, floated out to path three for the stretch run, altered in when his path was taken inside the final furlong then made up minor ground. NACHO FRIEND boxed in briefly, had a clear path along the rail going to the second turn, could not keep up, angled out to path three midstretch and failed to have a significant response. STORMING SAINT in midpack from path four on the backstretch, was just off the inside into the second bend, swung out four wide for the drive and had little to offer. MCKENNA'S JUSTICE stumbled at the start, saved ground nearly all the way and failed to menace. CLASSICAL SLEW gradually faded five wide on the backstretch, was just off the inside taking the second turn and empty for the stretch run. GUILTBYASSOCIATION steadily backed up from outside, angled in entering the second bend and had little left.
