DOS AND DON'TS was allowed to settle early, vied three wide to gain a short advantage, drifted in at the top of the stretch forcing CITYFIED to steady then altered outward nearing the wire and held. GALLOPING GULCH dropped back early, lost contact with the field down the backstretch, then rallied eight wide at the top of the stretch, found his best stride late and was gaining. NOW AND ZEN pressed the early pace from the inside, went evenly in the stretch but held the show. NO WALKIN' JOE was off slow early, sustained a bid three wide at the quarter pole and showed some effort late. MAJOR BILLLY was forwardly placed early, shuffled back into the turn then showed some interest late. BRONZE FOX was within striking distance early, went four wide at the quarter pole then weakened. FAIR MARKET VALUE showed little in a dull effort. CITYFIED set the early pace, drew clear into the turn, was forced to steady into the stretch when DOS AND DON'TS drifted in some then retreated. TEXAS BREWED raced wide and faded steadily. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
