Footnotes

RED ROCK SPRINGS pressed from outside, under a drive while in paths two or three taking the bend, gained the advantage just inside the furlong marker and driven clear the final sixteenth. LATTIN SLUGGER broke outward a bit, vied for the lead just off the inside, was clear on the turn, challenged from outside in the lane, no match for RED ROCK SPRINGS the last eighth and narrowly held the place. RIVER GRADE TRICK showed first, failed to keep up three wide on the bend, fanned out some for the stretch run, weaved around traffic some as he made his bid in the lane, was too late for second but proved clearly best of the rest. T E F'S STAR ONE away slowly, was then bumped and had to steady behind traffic, advanced along the rail on the turn, swung out some entering the lane, angled in upper stretch and gradually faded. HIGH SIETE chased from between rivals, was just off the inside leaving the bend and failed to have a late bid. ROANIE'S STAR broke inward, bumped hard with MAKENNA'S GOLD, showed no speed, saved ground on the turn and was empty for the stretch run. MAKENNA'S GOLD was bumped hard then squeezed between horses, checked, taken to the outside, checked hard again when another horse fell inside him on the turn then coasted the rest of the way. APOLLO GOLD was a brief contender from outside, fell on the turn and had to be vanned off. There was a stewards' inquiry into the race and an objection lodged by the rider of T E F'S STAR ONE alleging interference from LATTIN SLUGGER at the start. After their review, the stewards' posted no change.
