MI CASTA was jostled some at the start to get off slowly, moved up steadily, then circled the field six wide in the turn, gradually was gaining ground, drifted in nearing the wire and inched away. GAVITA was unhurried early, rallied six wide at the quarter pole and was closing well late. WESTERN WAY broke in at the break, then was forwardly placed early, went three wide at the quarter pole, was steadied nearing the sixteenth pole then altered outward and went evenly late. STORMIN BOMB set the early pace three wide, went between foes nearing the quarter pole then weakened in the lane. ONE HOT ANGEL raced mid pack, went four wide and sustained a mild effort late. PULPIT ACCOUNT was within striking distance early, rallied between foes in the turn then flattened in the drive. VERY SHINEY forced the early pace while saving ground, gained a short lead then tired and gave way. SRITA MINISTER was allowed to settle early racing off the inside and lacked a late response. TOMMY JO raced wide and was not a threat. FINISHRICH ON TIME was outrun early racing wide and was not a factor. A J'S FLICKA retreated steadily five wide. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
