Footnotes

EXPLOSIVE MINE soon had the lead, was clear just off the rail on the the turn then left the rest far behind with little asking through the lane. RUFFY TRICK in midpack early between rivals, took the turn three wide, battled for second in the stretch and got it late. MIDNIGHT MAVRICK was prominent between horses, three wide on the turn, tried to drift out leaving the bend, fought for second through the lane but narrowly missed. WILD TIME TONIGHT showed first but soon backed up from inside, fanned out to path three leaving the turn, had to weave through traffic deep stretch and just missed for third. FOURTEEN KT. GOLD bumped with VICTORY STAGE at the break, advanced from outside on the turn, was six wide into the stretch then slowly made up ground on those dueling for second place. VICTORY STAGE bumped with FOURTEEN KT. GOLD at the start, was an early contender between horses, five wide entering the lane and gradually wore down. IN FLAGS HONOR broke inward, chased EXPLOSIVE MINE from just off the rail and weakened the final furlong. HELIOBULL broke awkwardly then altered in, was just off the inside on the turn, fanned to path five for the stretch run and had little left.
