QUICKLY shared the lead in hand from outside, was asked in the lane and steadily opened up while ridden out. ADELITA'S GOLD showed first, vied for the lead from inside, was no match for the winner when set down in the stretch and narrowly held the place under a drive. SOME FUN forced in while between rivals nearing the turn, brushed with FEELIN LIKE DANCIN into the bend, was shuffled back, swung out behind TRAVELIN JONES into the lane, altered outside that one going to the eighth pole, closed with a rush after getting a clear path and just missed second. HUNTIN THE TRASH chased the early speed from between rivals, swung out early in the turn, moved to the inside leaving the bend, came off the rail midstretch and lacked a late bid. SCARLETTI advanced three wide on the turn, moved in beside HUNTIN THE TRASH entering the lane, altered outside that one as he came out midstretch and lacked a significant response. FEELIN LIKE DANCIN was without speed though hustled along from inside, brushed into the turn and failed to have a stretch bid. TRICK OR BOUNTY drifted out into the turn, appeared to shy out further as TRAVELIN JONES came close midway on the turn, stayed wide into the lane and had little to offer. TRAVELIN JONES was steadied along the rail shortly after the start, angled out into the bend, drifted out further, was corrected, four wide entering the stretch and continued to fade.
