BALLADO'S BULLET vied for the lead between rivals, had the advantage two wide leaving the bend, was headed upper stretch, dug in, regained the lead inside the eighth pole and held on under steady handling. BEWILD HENNESSY disputed the pace from outside, had a narrow advantage upper stretch, fought gamely to the wire, did not have enough in the waning yards but was easily second best. SOME KIND OF LUCK was hustled along to contest the pace from inside, could not stay with the top pair leaving the turn, angled three wide upper stretch and could only just hold his position. CHARMING DELTA fractious and loose several times during the post parade, pressed the early pacesetters, just off the inside on the turn, floated out some entering the lane, was altered in for a clear path nearing the eighth pole and had no late bid. SPY MASK was away slowly then steadied behind traffic, advanced along the rail on the turn, fanned four wide for the stretch run and lacked a significant response. SOMEKINDALOVELY was never a factor in a wide trip. PSYCHO GHOST broke inward slightly and gave way from between horses on the turn.
