**Footnotes**

SOARING DEA stalked the early leaders, moved to the inside approaching the turn, saved ground to the stretch, angled off the rail at the top of the lane, moved between foes at the eighth pole and surged late for the win. APPLELINA tracked the leaders while racing on the outside down the backstretch, loomed five wide into the turn, vied for the lead at the sixteenth pole and was outfinished late. VINTON ROW set the pace to the three sixteenth pole and steadily weakened in deep stretch. DESERT AVENUE saved ground to the stretch, swung out four wide and rallied belatedly. RYANGELA not far behind early, swung out three wide into the stretch and was no threat. DESERT FUN raced five wide into the turn and was no threat. LA LA LA DANDY tracked the leaders early and steadily weakened. KASHA ROO steadied turn and offered no rally.
