SKAR stalked from inside, swung out three wide leaving the turn, rallied to gain the advantage nearing the sixteenth marker then lugged in as he widened command in the waning yards. CAT SIMON soon had the lead, was clear nearing the turn, had the rail through the bend, was challenged in the stretch, could not stay with SKAR the final sixteenth but won his battle for the place. UNCLE JACK G pressed the early speed from outside, was two wide through the bend, vied for the lead upper stretch, was fighting for second the final sixteenth but did not have enough. RADCLIFFE MAN raced in contention just off the inside from the early going, fanned four wide leaving the turn and lacked the needed stretch bid. PASSEM PRO was steadied behind traffic near the half mile marker, angled out for a clear path on the turn, came six wide into the lane and closed well. DOMS DOMINATOR void of speed, was four and five wide taking the bend and lacked a stretch bid. HIGHLAND'S BEST showed first but was void of speed though hustled along, angled in on the turn and had little to offer for the drive. BOB'S BANJO stayed well off the inside throughout and showed little.
