KISSINGER was unhurried early, then loomed up into the turn four wide, closed well late and surged clear. EL GRAN COGNAC was forwardly placed early four wide, vied to gain a clear advantage at the eighth pole and failed to last. CRUSHER LANE was never far back early, went five wide to show some effort late and gained the show. BIG BLAZE set the early pace racing three wide then tired and weakened. VICTORIA'S CASE raced mid pack saving ground, drifted wide in the stretch and lacked a rally. SENOR PROSPECT forced the early pace racing off the rail, drifted out five wide and faded. LYONS PROSPECT was off slow early, drifted out wide and lacked a rally. R C DILLINGER showed little in a dull effort. NEEOCITY trailed the field and was always outrun.
