ADELITA'S GOLD stalked the early leaders from the outside, sustained a bid between rivals three wide, gained the lead at the eighth pole and drew clear. GOLDEN LANE was well back early racing four wide, rallied near the quarter pole splitting foes and found her best stride late. XCESSIVE LEAD pressed the early pace from along the inside then tired and weakened but held the show. CRAFTY JOI chased the early leaders racing off the rail, went four wide near the quarter pole and lacked a gain late. VOWSMAKEMEBLUSH was unhurried early, shuffled back into the turn, went six wide in the stretch and passed tiring foes. FAKE THIS raced mid pack four wide and lacked a late response. MISS A T M MACHINE was off slow early racing off rail and lacked a rally. CROP TOP set a pressured early pace from the outside, was used up and empty in the stretch.
