REUBENS WATCH was allowed to settle four wide, placed a bid to close well and got up in the final strides. NO MORE DAY'S pressed the early pace, gained the advantage inching away in the stretch but was out nodded by closing rival. WORTH A POT FULL was unhurried early saving ground, angled five wide into the stretch, closed fast in the late going and got up for the show. MY LIL LYNDA set a pressured early pace from the outside then tired after a half and weakened. NO LATE NIGHTS was outrun early saving ground and improved her position in the stretch. E R F SILVER BUNNY was off slow early, went seven wide nearing the quarter pole and lacked a bid. GOLDEN ROCKET showed little in a dull effort. A J'S FLICKA went six wide at the quarter pole and retreated steadily. There was a Steward Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
