Footnotes

QUICKKEY vied for the lead two wide of SUSPENDER while rating kindly, took over from that foe on the turn with little asking, drew off in the stretch under some left-handed urging and then was taken in hand nearing the wire. SUSPENDER pressed the winner from near the rail, was no match for that rival on the turn but continued on well in the drive to hold the place. SUDDENLY ALONE was taken back early, angled four wide midway of the turn for a mild rally that gained third a sixteenth out. LORD IMAJONES gave futile chase to the winner into the turn but could not keep up and weakened the rest of the way. DANCE OF CREATION raced evenly two wide. BELLA UNION tired badly racing along the rail.
