CHIEF LAZ prompted the early pace three wide, rallied in the stretch closing, drew clear and widened. TEXAS SILVER stalked the early leader four wide, vied into the stretch, was no match late and followed the winner in the stretch. THREEGOODKIDS was unhurried early, raced wide in the stretch with a mild bid and gained the show. MILLER WHO was void of early speed racing along the inside, angled three wide and showed some effort late. STONE COLD ODDS was allowed to settle early racing off the rail, angled in along the rail and lacked a rally late. GOLDEN M P raced mid pack six wide and lacked a closing response. CAHONE CREEK set the early pace saving ground and was finished early. FULL OF PRIDE dropped back and failed to threaten.
