JAMMIN GEARS angled out four wide between into lane, rallied in the stretch and just got up at the wire. ANY QUESTIONS set the early rapid pace, held safe advantage in the stretch and was denied the win at the wire. KEAGAN saved ground, came six to eight wide and closed fast on the far outside. ABSOLUTELY TRUE threw head at the start, came six wide and closed belatedly. EN EL FUEGO came two to three wide, was steadied on the rail at the sixteenth pole and was gaining late. ZAMRITE came four wide, angled in sharply at the sixteenth pole and finished evenly. BIZMARAQUE pressed, dueled and gave way. TAKIN ISSUE advanced five wide, was brushed by foe at the three sixteenths pole and flattened out. JEFFRIES BAY advanced on the inside, lacked room on the rail and was steadied at the quarter pole. PRIMARY SUSPECT advanced five wide and yielded. Following the race the rider of the #8 lodged an objection against the winner the #4. After reviewing the race replay the Steward's ruled that there was no change.
