BREW set the pace under pressure from the rail, slowed the pace down the backstretch, lost his lead briefly on the second turn, battled back along the rail with less than a sixteenth to go and prevailed under an all out drive. GENTLEMAN BEAU alternated for the lead with BREW, was hard pressed throughout, dueled gamely in the lane and just missed. BIG CHANGE loomed the danger from five deep, gained a slight edge nearing the quarter pole, fought gamely in the lane and was just edged on the wire. THATSUSINTHEOLBEAN forced the issue from the outset, joined the front from between rivals in the lane, dueled to the sixteenth pole, then got outfinished. MR. EXCITEMENT taken back off the pace a bit, got through along the rail on the second turn, offered a middle move, but could not sustain that bid. LINE GUAGE settled back nicely from off the rail, ranged up six deep on the second turn, hung, then faded in the drive.
