Footnotes

POCKETFULLAPOZZIES forced the issue from two wide, raced on even terms in the lane, was fully extended to prevail at the wire. CHIPPER J. set the fractions under steady pressure, dug in gamely at the rail and was just caught. WAMPUS WHO tracked the leaders from the outset, drifted out in the lane, rallied under urging to finish well. FRITZIE'S PROSPECT outpaced early on, closed well from between foes in the lane and made a steady gain in the drive. SWEET WINK lacked early foot, forged a mild rally in the lane. KING'S FORTUNE battled three across the track to the stretch, then faded when set down for the drive. SNAKES P J lacked early foot, bored out on the turn and lost ground. WILD BILL R rushed up five deep nearing the three eighths pole, bored out sharply, was forced to steady and lost all forward progress. PURPLE SLIPPERS showed no early speed while lugging out on the turn. EMBARCADERO stalked the pace to the turn, then pulled up quickly in the lane, was walked off the course. The opening fraction was hand timed.
