Footnotes

DIAMOND CHARM set the early pace while saving ground, edged clear in the stretch and held off closing rival at the wire. BELLE OF ABO was within striking distance early, placed a steady effort racing six wide into the stretch and was gaining late. EXOTIC PROGRAM was off slow early, gained steadily into the turn, swung out seven wide near the quarter pole and showed some interest late. HUNTER HIGH was unhurried early, vied in the stretch splitting foes, altered in at the sixteenth pole then flattened. TULAROSA was hustled away along the inside and failed to respond. GOSSIP DOME was void of early speed, went three wide and placed a mild bid. MISPLACED MEMO raced mid pack and lacked a gain late. GHOST OF SCOTLAND was outrun early, drifted out seven wide near the quarter pole and lacked a rally. LIKA LYNX was forwardly placed early then faded steadily. GHOSTLY WHISPER prompted the early pace four wide then gave way. CHANTILLY CAT showed some brief speed four wide, was finished early, taken up in the stretch and walked off.
