### Footnotes

AFFLUENT BOY was forwardly placed early racing off the inside, angled out between rivals at the three sixteenths, sustained a bid through the stretch, dug in the final yards to prevail. VERNY set the early pace three wide, was headed near the five sixteenths, dueled into the stretch, battled to the wire in a game try. LESTER'S ECHO forced the early pace from the inside, angled out four wide near the eighth pole and yielded. MOSTLY DUST was within striking distance early, vied six wide to duel briefly then weakened. PURE D GOLD broke sharply then prompted the pace from the outside six wide and lacked a gain late. CALI BABY was void of early speed saving ground, placed a rally in the stretch then flattened. REAL FLAXY was outrun early racing off the inside and lacked a late effort. BONNDADDY'S was off slow early, placed a mild bid five wide then went evenly. MAYBE TO FAST was outrun early, raced wide and lacked a bid. VINCENT dropped back early, went five wide and was not threat. D J'S DIAMOND raced along the inside and faded steadily.
