Footnotes

A TO THE Z settled far back early, then launched a seven wide rally into the stretch and was put to fierce urging to get up near the wire under a perfectly timed ride. PLEASANT BEND made a three wide bid at the quarter to challenge NOVEL T DREAMER but was soon forced in a bit by the loose HAITIAN HIT, angled back out to be clear and had the lead late but was outfinished. WISHINGITWAS made a four wide bid into the stretch and dueled to the end but hung. FACE THE BAND rallied from far outside to improve position in the drive. FAME INA MINUTE called on NOVEL T DREAMER two wide on the second turn but lost his path nearing the stretch and subsequently tired. NOVEL T DREAMER controlled the pace from near the rail through the far turn while apparently well in hand but gave way in the stretch. DALT'S KINGPIN put in an even effort two wide. DEFRERE'S VIXEN tracked the pace three wide between horses down the backside but had nothing left for the drive. TOP HIT tired after a four wide trip. STREAK OF ROYALTY gave chase from inside but was already tiring on the turn and was on empty in the stretch. RAYO DE PLATA tired on the second turn and coasted home. HAITIAN HIT stumbled at the start and lost his rider.
