COOKIE RULES was allowed to settle early racing off the inside, vied angling out six wide, gained the lead then widened in deep stretch. STRUT N TUTT advanced four wide, gained the lead briefly, drifted out into the stretch, was challenged nearing the eighth pole and was no match late. BEAU'S HALO was unhurried early, went between foes four wide at the quarter, sustained a bid mid stretch then flattened. ALMOST SUMMER raced mid pack, went seven wide near the quarter pole and lacked a gain late. FLEETING SUMMER was off slow early, was wide in the stretch and showed some interest late. EVER POWERFUL dropped steadily back down the backstretch, placed a mild bid near the quarter pole then went evenly in the stretch. T DRIVE was outrun early saving ground, sustained a brief bid mid stretch then gave way. CAT'S BOY BURN was within striking early racing off the inside and lacked a bid. FLYER BE QUICK prompted the early pace racing along the rail then faded. GUILTBYASSOCIATION showed some brief speed racing off the inside then retreated. SIERRA SEVEN trailed the field and was not a factor.
