SLEWCHERO set a pressured early pace racing off the rail, drove clear into the stretch and widened. GRANNY'S WILL chased the early leaders racing off the rail, closed two wide into the stretch but was no match for the winner. COMIC TALK stalked the early leaders racing four wide, sustained a brief bid then weakened. DIESEL INJUN raced mid pack, went five wide in the stretch with a mild effort late. STEVE'S FANTASY was off slow early, raced two or three wide and lacked a late response. SHAWNEE CHOPIN was outrun early racing off the rail and passed tiring ones late. FOREVER ROLLING pressed the early pace between foes and was finished early. LANE'S STORM raced wide throughout and placed a mild effort. SHUG'S STORM CAT prompted the early pace saving ground then faded. JOHNNY'S JEWEL showed little in a dull effort. PROSPECTOR MAN dropped back early and was not a factor. HEREDADARE failed to threaten and was vanned off after pulling up.
