ECHO OF HOPE was unhurried early, closed the gap racing just off the rail, angled out four wide near the three sixteenth and wore down his foes. PAULS HEART dueled five wide, gained a short lead at the eighth pole, battled hard then yielded in the final strides. RADCLIFFE MAN dueled from between foes, gained a short advantage at the quarter then weakened in the final furlong. DANCINGTHRUTHENITE forced the early pace from between rivals, was in tight quarters into the turn, was taken up some then fought back in the stretch five wide. DOMS DOMINATOR was unhurried early racing off the rail and showed some interest late in the stretch. TOP DANCER dueled from along the inside and was finished early. COPELAN'S ACE was outrun early, went the widest in the stretch and lacked a rally. THATS MR. TO YOU failed to threaten. EVENING WITH CHIME showed some brief speed dueling between rivals, was taken up at the top of the stretch and vanned off.
