BIRDIE'S GENIUS stalked the pace from the rail, then lugged out in the turn and closed willingly in the stretch drive. RAMOUR got off slow and saved ground, then rallied up the rail to get up for place. KEY TO THE BAND broke slow, then angled out in the turn and closed going four wide. SCIFI HERO dueled for the lead from the rail but gave way at the sixteenth pole. SUAVEY forced the pace going three to four wide and offered a mild bid late. FIRE E BEAN was near the back, two wide with a mild rally. SPEEDY DOMZALEZ dueled for the lead, three wide and flattened out at the sixteenth pole. BORN BOND was mid field, then angled out going five wide with no late run. K D RANSOM had no early speed, four wide and lacked the needed late response. GOLD GULCH no early foot, five wide, no rally. WEST OF TEXAS near back, steadied turn, retreated. QWIKNICKELSSLOWDIME pressed the pace, four wide and faded at the five sixteenth pole.
