Footnotes

PRETTY BOY TROY tracked the leaders, raced five wide into the turn, vied for the lead at the five sixteenths and drew off late. MATAGOT lagged behind early, moved out eight wide into the turn, was gaining deep stretch and was no match for the winner. SEATTLE'S PACHE unhurried early, advanced four wide into the turn and had some late gain. MAJOR AFFAIR second flight early while saving ground, moved behind horses deep stretch and offered a mild rally. DANI'S BIRTHDAY stalked the early leaders, advanced six wide into the turn and finished evenly. ROJOCANGO mid pack early, moved three wide into the turn and offered no rally. OILFIELD TRASH lagged behind early, moved eight wide turn and was never a threat. DIAMOND MIKE pressed the early pace and stopped at the three eighths pole. DEREKSON led, while saving ground and tired at the three eighths.
