Footnotes

TRISTANS SLEW soon had the lead, set the pace just off the inside, was all out in the lane and held off SLEWS WINNER. The latter, forwardly placed outside, bid three wide on the turn, found best stride too late the final furlong but proved clearly best of the rest. GHOST WITH DA MOST in midpack from outside, made his move four wide on the turn, drifted out some upper stretch, held a straight path the final eighth, could not close the gap but caught MATCHSTICK MAN for third. MATCHSTICK MAN in the second flight between rivals, was two wide taking the bend, angled out some after entering the final furlong and lacked the needed bid. CRAFTY PROGRAM blocked and looking for room shortly after the start, had a clear path three wide on the turn, failed

to rally between horses in the lane and was altered out to stay clear of MATCHSTICK MAN late. CAT KING COLE void of speed, had the rail into the bend, swung out five wide entering the stretch, gradually angled out as GHOST WITH DA MOST came out upper stretch and steadily advanced. TUPAY gradually backed up from between rivals, two to four wide taking the turn then slowly made up ground without threatening through the lane. KAWANA BAND was also without early foot between horses, advanced three wide on the turn and was closing the gap the final eighth. JICK JACK JOKER was away slowly ad failed to menace in a wide trip. O K'S BLUFF prominent just off the inside on the backstretch, gave way the last quarter mile. MARRONE pressed from inside, faded along the rail on the turn, was steadied when his path narrowed leaving the turn, altered out some, steadied behind O K'S BLUFF at the head of the lane, altered in and continued to give way.
