Footnotes

SOME FUN showed first, was rated off the early speed, altered in entering the stretch, came off the rail some leaving the bend, bumped with RED HOT FAVORITE as he vied for the lead into the stretch, gained the advantage nearing the eighth pole then steadily drew away under a drive the final furlong. SPINNING TOUCH without early foot, angled in near the half mile marker, was three to five wide taking the turn, steadily improved position under a drive through the lane and caught AWESOME AMIGO for second nearing the wire. AWESOME AMIGO bore in at the start, crowding some of those inside him, pressed from outside, bid for the lead four wide on the turn, had a slight and brief lead at the top of the stretch, could not stay with SOME FUN inside the last eighth, battled to hold the place but was outfinished. RED HOT FAVORITE contested the pace toward the outside, three wide taking the bend, bumped with SOME FUN into the lane, fought for second the last furlong, did not have enough left but was easily best of the rest. ELEGANT MOVES dueled for the lead just off the inside, gained the rail nearing the quarter pole, began to tire and gradually drifted out in the stretch. BUZZ GONE WILD forced in at the break, bumped with LA LOMA, was steadied then gradually advanced in a wide trip. SUNLAND BLUES was an early contender from inside but faded along the rail leaving the bend. DONTKISSDAPREACHER disputed the pace between horses but faded just off the inside leaving the turn. KEEGANS REALITY

was away slowly then checked behind traffic, stayed well off the inside, swung out widest for the drive and had little to offer. PUNCH THE TICKET was checked behind traffic leaving the chute, faded four wide on the turn, fanned out further entering the lane and also had little left. LA LOMA was bumped and checked at the start, backed up from between horses, angled in on the turn and continued to fade along the rail through the stretch.
