Footnotes

WHERE'S MY MONEY was unhurried early saving ground, angled out at the top of the stretch to sustain a bid three wide, closed with strong urging and was up in the final strides. WHATYOURGONNAGET set the early pace from the outside, duelled briefly with SHARAN'S PRIDE at the top of the stretch, gained a short lead at the eighth pole and was denied at the wire by closing foe. SHARAN'S PRIDE forced the early pace from the inside, vied nearing the quarter pole to duel briefly into the stretch then flattened out. WAGERMONEY HONEY was steadied at the start to get away slowly and showed some late effort in the stretch. READY STEADY GO saved ground then angled out four wide and placed a mild bid. MALEK MAKER chased the early leaders three wide then faded. PRINCE CARSON pressed the early pace three wide and was finished early. BITTENBYTHELAW trailed the field and was always outrun.
