Footnotes

HENNESSY ROAD dueled four wide into the stretch, responded well when asked to draw clear nearing the wire to prove best. STAR OF WONDER dueled from between foes into the turn and failed to match strides with the winner. FALLON FONTANE was unhurried early racing five wide, drifted out in the stretch late and closed well. SILVER FLAIR was forwardly placed early saving ground, angled out four wide then flattened in the drive. PARK LANE LASS was allowed to settle early, went six wide near the quarter pole and lacked a rally. CHURNING was outrun early racing three wide and lacked a closing response. LA LA LA DANDY was off slow early saving ground, angled out four wide and improved her position. CINNAMON ROLL prompted the early pace then faded steadily. QUINTON'S QUEEN raced mid pack saving ground and lacked a bid. GONE DANDY raced wide throughout and was not a factor. The rider of FALLON FONTANE claimed interference against the rider of HENNESSY ROAD and after reviewing the films it was determined there would be no change.
