SINISTER ERIC dueled four wide into the stretch, dug in near the sixteenth pole and edged clear. BREAK MY TRICK was settled early, lugged out in the turn, went six wide into the stretch and closed well. BOLGER LANE was fractious in the gate pre start, then dueled early along the rail and yielded in the drive. TOBAPRINCE forced the early pace, went three wide between foes and placed a mild bid. MARTY SQUALL raced mid pack, went five near the quarter pole and lacked a late response. DANCE DERBY was unhurried early, went five wide and placed a mild effort. R REEL DEAL was outrun early, went six wide and showed little. SHES ALY was off slow early racing off the inside, angled four wide and lacked a bid. MEDITATING KARLA stumbled at the break to get away slowly then saved ground to no avail. DEVON'S IRON GIANT trailed the field and was always outrun.
