MAGNANIMITY stalked the early leaders three wide, was between rivals into the second turn, placed a bid to surge clear nearing the quarter pole and opened up to the wire. POWERSFOX was void of early speed, gained steadily into the stretch, went six wide at the quarter pole, altered in and finished willingly along the inside. GRAND SLAM PETE was within striking distance early, angled out four wide to place a brief bid then yielded in the drive. JAC CADILLAC was off slow early, saved ground throughout, rallied late and placed a mild gain. CALL IN was unhurried early, went three wide and lacked a late effort. EVENTFUL CONQUEST drew quickly clear angling in to save some ground then gave way in the stretch. WILD RIVER RUN was forwardly placed early then faded steadily. HANGMAN'S GULCH was outrun early racing off the rail and lacked a bid. CATALYTIC saved ground to no avail. JANS CACHE raced mid pack early then retreated.
