OUTLAW AVENUE drew clear of the field early, going wire to wire, to be ridden out as the easy winner. GET UP TAYLOR was mid field on the rail, then angled out in the turn and rallied to get up for second. THEO was near the front, two wide, then made a mild bid and got up for show. KAWANA BAND was forwardly placed early going three wide, then gave way at the sixteenth pole. D E KINGS RANSOM had no early foot, three wide and offered a mild bid late. ANGEL THE BULL broke well on the inside but lacked the needed late response. ABO TRICK had no early speed from the rail with no late run. EASTERN GOLD was near the back, four wide and passed a tiring foe. CASHETE stalked the pace going four wide with a mild bid early, then retreated at the five sixteenths pole.
