Footnotes

SCOOTONOVER dueled in the early going with ROLL DEVIL ROLL, went three wide at the quarter pole, kicked clear nearing the eighth pole and widened late. LUCKY LESTER was within striking distance early while saving ground, sustained a bid to gain the place but was no match for the winner and clearly the best of the rest. BIG BLAZE was forwardly placed early, went four wide showing some effort late to get up for the show. ROLL DEVIL ROLL showed some brief speed from the outside then weakened. PLATINUM PRO was outrun early, went four wide and showed some interest late. DASHKOVA was off slow early racing off the inside, vied into the stretch, then was steadied nearing the eighth pole, altered outward four wide and lacked a gain late. MISS DESERT FREEZE was allowed to settle early, was along the inside into the stretch and lacked a late effort. DE SO LONG COWBOY raced mid pace off the inside, lacked a rally in the stretch and was vanned off after pulling up. BIG FIND showed little racing wide and was not a factor. COLE'S EGO was well back early and was never a threat.
