**Footnotes**

HENNESSYLADYLEGEND was hustled early to set the pace, lost the advantage in the turn, battled back in the stretch and edged clear. KATIE'S PROSPECT was off slow early, gained steadily into the stretch, went five wide and found her best stride late. GYPSY GAL prompted the early pace from between rivals, angled in to save ground, placed a bid drawing clear in the stretch and faltered when challenged. SEEKING THE STONE was allowed to settle early saving ground, angled three wide to vied in the stretch but was outfinished in the late going. PULPIT ACCOUNT was outrun early, closed the gap five wide and showed some effort late. BALOU'S BO BO raced mid pack six wide in the early going and placed a mild effort late. TRICKYLOOKER was void of early speed saving ground and sustained a mild bid late. BIT O SWEET was forwardly placed early four wide then weakened. DANZIG TERA was unhurried early and lacked a late effort. COURTLY PROSPECT was void of early speed racing off the inside, was wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. TWICE THE GHOST retreated steadily three wide. NO ONE YET was within striking distance early, drifted out at the quarter pole then gave way.
