MY DEAR COUNTRY was slow early and allowed to settle into stride, raced five wide into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and drew clear under steady urging. TRAININTHEINFLUNCE unhurried early, raced up to gain the lead on the turn while racing eight wide, was no match for the fast closing MY DEAR COUNTRY and was vanned off after the race. IAREAFERRARA advanced while racing along the inside and showed a good effort. WILDINTHEWILDWEST was off slowly, offered a bid in mid stretch but failed to sustain his rally in the late going. PRINCE LONGFELLOW raced between rivals in the second flight, was four wide into the stretch, showed a mild rally but lacked the needed late response. PICKIN UP CHICKS stalked the pace from between foes into the stretch and gave way. BEHRS REPEATING was unhurried early, raced four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ASHIR was finished after racing a half mile. BLOODY MARY AT T'S showed brief speed and tired. SALT THE VAULT led for a half mile and faltered. O'CONNELL dueled into the stretch and tired. SPIRIT OF THE WEST was never a factor.
